Total number of gallons in case	3.17 gal
Cost per gal	\$1.26/gal
Cost to buy same amount of bottled water that an RO produces in 1 year	2,184 gal = \$2,751.84

Bottled Water Facts

- Americans spent more than \$15 billion on bottled water in 2015
- Only about 30% of bottles get recycled, the rest end up in landfills
- Every year the equivalent of 50 million barrels of oil are used to process, transport, and refrigerate bottled water
- Bottled water is not always purified, some are just packaged tap water
- Plastic bottles can contain harmful chemicals which can leech into the water and increase your risk of chemical exposure
